



Community Workers (x3)

We are currently recruiting for 3 Community Workers, to support our Development Officer in the delivery of SCOREscotland's Green Futures Project.

You will be required to enable the project to reach as many people as possible from diverse B/ME communities in South West Edinburgh. You will also be required to identify the needs of different community members and to take a lead in the delivery of the energy efficiency advice appointments.

Successful delivery of this project will need workers from different communities with a diversity of community languages and experience.

We are recruiting three Community Workers in order to minimise the risks of lone working and to provide extra flexibility for delivering events and sessions.

The Community Workers will be Reporting to: The Green Futures Development Officer.

Salary and hours

Salary: £22,750 (pro rata) (with 12% pension after 12 weeks probationary period)

Length of contract: Just under 18 months

Hours: 14 hours each per week (28 hours per week for the first three and a half months and the last three months of the project, these extra hours can be worked flexibly if necessary).
