Wester Hailes – Our Place in Time

This presentation will provide a detailed and fascinating history of Wester Hailes from the late 1960s through to the present day. Much of this will be drawn from the archives of the Wester Hailes Sentinel - the very popular community newspaper which was published regularly from the mid 1970s - including a name change to the West Edinburgh Times - until 2008. In particular, information and photographs will be made available via the Wordpress blog and associated Facebook pages of the "From There to Here" social history webpage run by Prospect Community Housing after protecting the Sentinel archives when that paper closed. Also referred to will be other sources of Wester Hailes historical information such as Capital Collections at the Central Library, the Royal Commission on the Ancient and Historical Monuments of Scotland and "Fae Westburn". The session will be run jointly by Caroline Richards of Prospect Community Housing and long term local resident Eoghan Howard. Come along to find out more about the history of the area!

SWAP access programmes are delivered by local colleges across Scotland and are designed for adults returning to education after a gap. These access programmes offer a potential route into hundreds of university degrees and college HNCs and HNDs.

What can I study?

SWAP access programmes cover a range of subjects, including arts and social sciences, primary education, languages, business, sciences, engineering, and nursing. All of the programmes are full-time and last one year, starting in August or September.

I didn't do so well at school. Could this still be for me?

Yes! You don't normally need to have any formal educational qualifications to apply to join a SWAP access programme. SWAP gives adult learners a second chance at education and the opportunity to fulfil their academic potential.

I'm too old!

You are never too old to learn or to join a SWAP programme! People of all ages study on access programmes, from all sorts of backgrounds and for lots of different reasons. Thousands of people have already succeeded through SWAP. You could too.
